Short Term Certificate Course in "Maintenance and Repairs of Instruments, PCB Designing, Fabrication and Assembly".

The Department of Physics, Government College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Sanquelim, in association with Directorate of Higher Education (DHE), Govt. of Goa organised a Short Term Certificate Course on "Maintenance and Repairs of Instruments, PCB Designing, Fabrication and Assembly".

The Inaugural function of the STCC was held on 11th February 2023. Prof. Sonia Sirsat, Vice-principal, Academics of the College was the Chief Guest. In her address to the gathering, she encouraged and motivated the students to actively participate in the STCC. The function was compered by Ms. Daneca da Cruz, Asst.
