MEMORANDUM OF UNDESTANDING
BY AND BETWEEN
GOVERNMENT COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIECNE AND COMMERCE, SANQUELIM, GOA
AND
VIVEKANAND ENVIRONENT AWARESS BRIGADE, KERI, SATTARI, GOA

THIS MEMORUNDUM OF UNDESTANDING (hereinafter called MoU) is executed on this day of 18th November 2022 between **GOVERNMENT COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIECNE AND COMMERCE, SANQUELIM- GOA** (hereinafter referred to as (GCASCS) AND **VIVEKANAND ENVIRONMENT AWARENESS BRIGADE, KERI, SATTARI – GOA** (hereinafter referred to as VEAB, GOA). For the purpose of this MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING, the Parties are hereinafter individually referred to as PARTY and collective as the 'PARTIES'.

WHEREAS the parties having discussed the fields of common research interests and allied activities between them, have decided to enter into a long-term collaboration in the area of Environment Education, Awareness and Conservation Initiatives, Education Training, Research and Co-curricular and extracurricular activities.

AND WHERSAS the parties herein above have considered it expedient to agree in writing to participate jointly in undertaking students and faculty related assignments to enhance the quality of college as per the expertise and logistics available with either PARTY.

NOW THEREFORE THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

ARTICLE 1. – OBJECTIVES

The Objectives of this MOU are:



- 1.1 Interaction of faculty members and students for research and academic purpose.
- 1.2 Use of Laboratory Instrumentation and Library facilities.
- 1.3 Provide better platform for the faculty and students to undertake research in various fields of mutual interest and have interaction with the experts.
- 1.4 Mutual utilization of professional competency and expertise to promote awareness in the community.
- 1.5 Act as the link institution for taking the indigenous knowledge to the community.

ARTICLE 2- AREAS OF RESEARCH CO-OPERATION

- 2.1 Pure Sciences

- 2.3 Earth Sciences
- 2.4 Bio-diversity

ARTICLE 3.– FORMS OF CO-OPERATION

- 3.1 Joint Research projects



- 3.2 Academic Projects /Programmes
- 3.3 Seminars and Lectures on topics of mutual interest and relevance
- 3.4 Training and research in mutually agreed areas of cooperation
- 3.5 Day and Residential Workshops on topics of mutual interest
- 3.6 Summer training for students/faculty

ARTICLE 4 – EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION

4.1 The term 'information' includes scientific or technical data, results and/or methods of investigation and other information intended to be provided, exchanged or arising under the objective identified under the Article – I. The PARTIES shall take all measures to protect secrecy of and avoid disclosure and unauthorized use of the information which is confidential and outside the public domain.

ARTICLE 5 - PUBLICATIONS AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

5.1 Any research publications and intellectual property rights arising out of the students and joint research projects shall be jointly published and when patented, will be jointly and equally owned by GCASCS and VEAB, GOA.

5.2 The procedural formalities for securing and maintaining the intellectual property rights shall be the responsibility of both GCASCS and VEAB, GOA and the expenditure incurred therefore shall be borne jointly and equally by GCASCS and VEAB, GOA.

5.3 The upfront fee and royalty accrued from licensing of any intellectual property arising from this collaboration to the other PARTY/IES shall be shared between the PARTIES, the terms and conditions of which shall be subject matter of a separate agreement between the PARTIES.



5.4 The PARTIES shall not assign any rights and obligations to any third PARTY without consent of other party.

ARTICLE 6 - IMPLEMENTATION

6.1 The PARTIES agree to constitute an Advisory Committee as follows:

6.2 The Advisory Committee shall meet at least once in a year at GCASCS or a VEAB to review the progress.

6.3 Based on the education, training and research requirement of students and staff, the advisory committee shall, in consultation with the faculty and scientists, decide on the topics and the mode of co-operation for each of the academic years during the tenure of this co-operation.

ARTICLE 7. -FINANCE

7.1 PARTY shall bear the cost collectively or as per the mutual agreement between the PARTIES to carry out the obligations under this MOU. Neither PARTY shall make a claim against the other PARTY for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon in writing between the PARTIES.

ARTICLE 8 – GENERAL PROVISIONS

8.1 Research instrumentation, infrastructure and library facilities available with the parties work place (s), shall be made available to the faculty, research scholars and students of the parties.

8.2 The PARTIES shall not use any of the confidential information which is required to be held confidence for any purpose other than performances of their obligations under this MOU.

8.3 The implementation of the areas and forms of co-operation identified under Articles II and III shall be subject to the availability and convenience of research students, faculties available at the PARTIES' work places.

8.4 The PARTY organizing an item of work shall have the nodal responsibility for mobilizing resources and the conduct of such works



8.5 All the questions related to this understanding arising during its term shall be settled by the PARTIES by mutual agreement. The disagreement at the operating level shall be forwarded to the respective higher officials for appropriate resolution, failing which an Arbitrator of mutual acceptance may be appointed.

8.8 Nothing in this Memorandum is intended to affect any other co-operation or collaboration between PARTIES.

8.9 All the collaboration activities pursuant to this Memorandum shall be conducted in accordance with the laws and regulations governing GCASCS and VEAB, GOA.

ARTICLE 9 – ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND TERMINATION

9.1 This MOU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the PARTIES and shall be valid for three years. This MOU may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either PARTY, by giving one month's notice in writing to the other PARTY.



9.2 All the joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of this Agreement may be continued until their completion, under the terms of this understanding.

ARTICLE 10- AMENDMENTS

10.1 This MOU represents the entire understanding between the PARTIES and supersedes any and all understandings either oral or written hitherto with respect to the subject matter of this understanding.

10.2 No amendment or modification of this MOU, shall be valid unless the same is signed by both PARTIES and specially stating the same to be amendment of the MoU. The modifications/ changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made /executed, unless otherwise agreed to.

ARTICLE 11 –ASSIGNMENT

11.1 This MoU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither party shall, transfer or assign this move and /or rights or obligation assigning there under, either wholly or in part to any third party.


ARTICLE 12 - NON- EXCLUSIVITY



This MoU has been executed in two copies, one of which will be retained by GCASCS and other by VEAB, GOA.




