Annual Report 2023-24

Government College of Arts, Science, and Commerce, Sanquelim, Goa

The academic year 2023-24 at Government College of Arts, Science, and Commerce, Sanquelim, Goa, was a year of active participation and engagement for both students and faculty in a variety of academic, extracurricular, and community-oriented activities. The college undertook several initiatives that were aligned with national and global trends, with a particular focus on fostering youth development, environmental awareness, cultural enrichment, and academic excellence. The following sections provide a detailed overview of the major activities conducted by various departments and clubs within the institution.

Yuva Tourism Club

The Yuva Tourism Club was established under the aegis of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav initiative by the Ministry of Tourism, aiming to promote youth involvement in the preservation of India's rich cultural and geographical heritage. The club focused on educating and engaging the youth in exploring tourism as a vital aspect of India's heritage. Under the leadership of Mr. Stephen Fernandes, with Vivek Mudada as the student co-ordinator, the club had 15 active student members. The club organized multiple events throughout the academic year. One of the major events was the *Tourism Day Celebration* on September 27, 2023, which featured a resource talk by Mr. Gavin Dias, General Manager of the Goa Tourism Development Corporation (GTDC), who spoke about the significance of sustainable tourism. The event also included various competitions such as logo-making, poster-making, photography, and a quiz focused on tourism. Another notable event organized by the club was a Wildlife Conservation Talk held on October 9, 2023. The talk, delivered by Mr. Geeriesh Bailudkar, the Range Forest Officer (RFO) of Mhadei Wildlife Sanctuary, emphasized the importance of wildlife conservation, especially in Goa's diverse ecosystems. The club also organized a Tourism Trail on March 1, 2024, which involved visits to Carambolim Lake, Old Goa Churches, and Mangueshi Temple, highlighting the ecological and historical significance of these locations while also promoting ecotourism.

National Service Scheme (NSS)

The NSS Unit of the college made significant strides in contributing to the community and fostering social responsibility among students. Under the guidance of faculty in-charge, the NSS Unit participated in a variety of programs aimed at environmental conservation, health awareness, and national service. One of the most impactful activities was the *Tree Plantation*

Drive conducted in August 2023, in which 75 saplings were planted in Morlem Village as part of the *Meri Mati Mera Desh* initiative. This was followed by a *Rakhi Making Competition*, where students crafted 1,147 rakhis, which were then sent to the Indian Army as a gesture of solidarity and gratitude. The NSS unit also participated in *Cleanliness and Anti-Plastic Drives*, conducting campus and local market clean-up activities and distributing 1,500 paper bags to reduce plastic use. Another notable event was the *Blood Donation Drive* held on October 14, 2023, where 70 units of blood were successfully collected, contributing to the health and wellbeing of the local community. Furthermore, the NSS unit hosted the *Neighbourhood Youth Parliament* on March 11, 2024, which was inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister Dr. Pramod Sawant, encouraging youth participation in democratic processes.

Departmental Activities

Department of Geography

The Department of Geography conducted several enriching activities aimed at providing practical knowledge and enhancing students' understanding of geographical concepts. A major activity was a *Field Excursion* on August 24, 2023, where third-year students visited Gokak Waterfall to observe geological features and learn about water resource management. In December 2023, the department organized a *Study Tour* from December 5-13, 2023, where students visited Delhi, Manali, Amritsar, and Chandigarh, exploring the geography and historical landmarks of these regions. On January 15, 2024, the department celebrated *Geography Day*, featuring competitions such as poster-making, a quiz, map jigsaw, and bottle painting, designed to engage students creatively while deepening their understanding of geographical concepts.

Department of Physics

The Department of Physics also offered a variety of events aimed at stimulating students' interest in scientific exploration. On August 19, 2023, the department organized a guest talk on *High Energy Physics* delivered by Mr. Jaiprakash from IIT Goa. Additionally, the department conducted a series of workshops, including a *Basic Astronomy Workshop* on January 30, 2024, which provided students with a deeper understanding of celestial phenomena. Another major event was the *Robotics Workshop* held on March 9-10, 2024, where students learned about the fundamentals of robotics and automation. The department also organized an *Electronic Garage Workshop* on March 16, 2024, to introduce students to hands-on learning in electronics.

Department of Economics

The Department of Economics actively engaged students in discussions on contemporary economic issues through various academic and extracurricular activities. On August 15, 2023, the department organized a *Poster Making Competition* on the theme "Growth Stories of Indian Economy," allowing students to creatively explore economic development. Furthermore, the department also participated in several national-level competitions, with notable achievements such as the *Business Ideathon*, where Kartik Panshikar and Apoorva Karapurkar won first place on September 19, 2023. Additionally, the department organized a participation drive for the *RBI Essay Writing Competition* on October 3, 2023, allowing students to engage with important financial topics.

Startup and Incubation Activities

In line with promoting entrepreneurship, the college organized the *Goa Startup Yatra* on September 4, 2023. The event was aimed at encouraging students to explore entrepreneurship as a career path and provided them with insights into startup culture and resources available for budding entrepreneurs. Additionally, 16 students from the college participated in the *PMFME* initiative, which aims to promote entrepreneurship in food processing and related sectors.

Department of English

The Department of English organized several events to enhance the academic and cultural development of students. On January 2024, the department conducted a *Short-Term Certificate Course (STCC)* on "Research in English," aimed at fostering research skills among students. In September 2023, the department also celebrated *Multiculturalism Day*, which featured discussions on cultural diversity and its impact on society. Furthermore, the department's students participated in prestigious literary events, including the *Jaipur Literary Festival* in February 2024, and excelled in intercollegiate competitions, winning prizes at the *Pegasus* event held in January 2024.

Other Activities

In addition to the academic and extracurricular activities mentioned above, the college also participated in several government initiatives. The *NEP 2020 Monitoring Committee* produced a video on Goa's Ganesh celebrations, which was submitted as part of an awareness campaign. The college also donated teaching aids to local Anganwadis on March 16, 2024, supporting

early childhood education in the region. The college also promoted health and fitness awareness

through its participation in National Sports Day activities on August 29, 2023, which focused

on the importance of physical activity for overall well-being.
